Field Trip Guidelines

- Please verify field trip plans with the museum at least 2 weeks prior to your field trip.
- Maximum group size will vary depending on the specific location. All quantities should include children ages 5-17 and adults 18 and older. See details below:
 - Kennedy-Douglass Center: 25-30 maximum
 - Florence Indian Mound & Museum: 60-75 maximum
 - Pope's Tavern: 20-40 maximum
 - The Frank Lloyd Wright Rosenbaum House: 20-30 maximum

- The total admission costs may be paid upon your arrival.
- Feel free to request an invoice.
- Cash, card, or checks are accepted for large groups.
- There is no food served or sold on site, but we would be happy to direct you to nearby restaurants.

<u>Museum Manners-</u> Adults, be sure to review the following with your students prior to arrival.

- Stay with your group and stay safe.
- Do not leave without asking for permission from your teacher, chaperone, or a museum professional.
- Always use walking feet, not running feet.
- Always use your inside voice.
- Only touch the exhibit items the museum staff has given permission to touch. Do not touch glass cases, just look.
- No eating or drinking in the exhibit spaces.
- Be respectful of museum staff and volunteers, as well as other visitors.
